

## Student Statement of Rights

### Student Rights

- a safe, secure, and conducive to learning, study and wellness
- a positive environment reasonable to learning characterized by equality and mutual respect
- Students have a right not to be subjected to harassment, sexual harassment, bullying or discrimination, indignity, injury, or violence.
- Students have the right to free inquiry, expression, belief, political association, and assembly, provided they do not interfere with the rights of others,
- timely, objective, fair and appropriated academic evaluation methods that are reflective of academic, occupational and industry competencies
- Students have the right to reasonable access to statements of policies, procedures, and guidelines of ABL.
- timely notification of all academic and administrative decisions that affect their Training Institute community life.
- the protection of privacy and confidentiality of personal information, subject to limits in accordance with the law

## Student Responsibilities

- treat all members of the Training Institute with respect
- be honest and truthful and not make any false, misleading or inflammatory statements or allegations
- Students are expected to be individually responsible for their actions whether acting individually or in a group
- be engaged in the pursuit of learning within an ordered Institute environment
- report any wrongdoing or unlawful activities
